Meteghan Sewer Extension

An application for the Meteghan Sewer Extension was submitted through the Build Canads Fund on December 18th, 2014.

The proposed work, which would begin at the AF Theriault property and extend to close to the Placide Comeau Road in Meteghan River, will have the potential to connect up to 57 residences to the new system. Should our application be approved, the work will begin this summer. Paving, which was originally slated to happen in the same area this summer has been postponed and added to TIR's capital plan for next year.

Rendez-vous de la Baie

The Rendez-vous de la Baie Café closed its doors on December 24th, 2014 but will reopen in the spring as a new Social Enterprise Café under the direction of the Clare Organization Representing Persons with Disabilities (CORD). CORD will also take over the RVB boutique operations.
