PROJECT FILES:

Meteghan Sewer Treatment Plant

- The contract has been awarded to Gary Belliveau Construction and Excavation Ltd.
- Site preparation work starting this week.
- The goal is to begin pouring the concrete slab by July 29th.

Meteghan Sewer Extension

- Remaining landscaping has been completed JR Eisener. Project is now complete.
- Currently 1 business and 3 houses connected. Another 3 houses have contacted Jody expressing interest.

Clare Veteran's Centre

Awaiting word on our application to the Nova Scotia Department of Communities
Culture and Heritage, under the Community Facilities Improvement Program, for
funding to assist with renovation of the current upstairs washroom facilities.

Gran-Fondo

- Sponsorship campaign is now closed. Goal of \$10,000 has been surpassed. Actual amount raised is \$10,400 with an additional several thousand dollars worth of inkind contributions.
- As of July 19th, 478 people have registered.
- Paid accommodations within the Municipality are full. Have reached out to Rodd Grand, Digby Pines ABCC. For those wanting to stay closer to the event, a database of available homes, cottages and rooms for rent is available and is currently being expanded.

Elections 2016

- Preparation of voters list is in progress. Residents will be advised via ads in local papers as to when they can confirm they are on the voters list
- Nomination Day is September 13th (with nominations being accepted by appointment from September 6th)
- Election day is October 20th with Advance polling days from October 7th to October 14th
- Electronic voting (computer and telephone) available on advance polling days and on Election day
- Paper ballots available on Election Day only at polls.

Clare Health Centre

- The contract has been signed, the job is fully credited and resources have been assigned.
- Controls / materials are now being ordered
- Project schedule will be ready shortly
- The TRANE Project Manager assigned to this particular job is Brian Chiasson -(902) 456-9810
- Project cost \$170,000 + annual service contract at a cost of \$1,080 per month.

Clean Water and Waste Water Fund

- The application was submitted to the NS Department of Municipal Affairs on June 27th
- The total project cost is \$198,628. Funding split 50% federal / 25% provincial / 25% municipal

INTERNAL:

- Communications Committee New municipal website has been launched. Content will continue to be added in the coming days/weeks.
- **By-law review committee** The by-law committee met on July 15th with the municipal solicitor (Lynette Muise) to review proposed revisions to both the Dog By-law and the Peace, Order, Mischief and Nuisances By-law. The revisions will be completed by August 19th and the Committee will be meeting again on August 31st for a final review, with the goal of presenting these by-laws to Council for 1st reading in September.
- Audit Auditors will be at the Municipality for the first two weeks of August. Will look to have a meeting of the audit committee shortly thereafter with the goal of having the statements approved by Council at the September 21st Council meeting. The deadline for submission to the Province is September 30th.
