## PROJECT FILES:

### Meteghan Sewer Treatment Plant

- Project is advancing as planned. To our knowledge, no unforeseen difficulties have occurred.
- The cement work is done. The ground work is done. A few minor deficiencies have been identified and are being remedied.
- Currently waiting on the polymer mixing unit from Bishop Water Technologies Inc. and Scotia Tech Fluid Services Ltd. Expect delivery within two weeks.
- Project completion is estimated to be mid to late October

### **Garbage Collection**

- New contract start date is October 1, 2016
- Total of 4 employees, all from Clare
- Accounts have been set up at local garage (maintenance) and fuel vendor
- Employee meetings have already taken place to discuss routes, safety and customer service

### Clare Veteran's Centre

- Application to renovate upstairs washroom facilities bathrooms and install electronic sign has been submitted to ACOA. Awaiting word.
- Total project cost \$110,000. Cost share 50/50 between ACOA and the Municipality.

### Gran-Fondo

- As of September 20<sup>th</sup>, 880 people have registered. However, with volunteers and committee members, the Municipality is hosting some 1,100 individuals.
- Paid accommodations within the Municipality are full. Have reached out to Rodd Grand, Digby Pines ABCC. Bed bank is working well. To our knowledge, all participants have found lodging.

## Elections 2016

- Advance polling dates (electronic voting only) are October 7th to the 14<sup>th</sup>
- Election Day is October 15th, 2016
- Due to acclamations, Election Day "paper" polls will be reduced to 4
  - District 1 voters will vote at District 2 poll (CSAP vote only)
    - District 3 voters will vote at District 4 poll (CSAP vote only)
    - District 5 voters will vote at District 6 poll (CSAP vote only)
    - District 7 voters will vote at District 8 poll (CSAP vote only)
- Internet/telephone voting is of course also available.

## Cape St. Mary Lighthouse

- Parks Canada has now designated the Cape St. Mary Lighthouse as a heritage lighthouse
- DFO is currently in the process of publizing the disposal of the lighthouse pursuant to the Heritage Lighthouse Protection Act.
- Once the public notice is made, the Municipality must wait 90 days before closing escrow
- In the meantime, we are currently working on a project application to ACOA which would see the Municipality leverage its funds and allow for further renovations / improvements to the site. We currently have \$77,000 committed to this project and requesting matching funding from the Agency

# **Clare Health Centre**

- The piping modifications are now complete.
- The duct heaters (40) are all installed except for one that didn't fit in the ceiling space – a different unit had to be ordered - it will be installed as soon as it arrives.
- The electrician started this week as well as the controls technician. The majority of the electrical work should be done this week.
- The controls wiring should largely be complete this week.
- Next week will be all controls work- programming and mapping, point checks and commissioning.
- Should be ready for training and hand over first week of October.
- The TRANE Project Manager assigned to this particular job is Brian Chiasson -(902) 456-9810
- Project cost \$170,000 + annual service contract at a cost of \$1,080 per month.
