Community support for the reopening of the Centre Acadien is very high as it is a necessary and wonderful tool in preserving Acadian culture and heritage. There is a dire community need for the reopening of the Centre.

The urgency of the reopening is steadily increasing with the pending Congrès Acadien Mondial in 2024.

Could the municipal council of Clare send a letter of support to University St Anne to reopen Le Centre Acadian as soon as possible?
